



Waterfront Director

The Town of Stratford is currently accepting applications for the position of Waterfront Director. This position is responsible for planning and safety of the two beaches, municipal pool, and wading pool.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following, but are not limited to,

- Conducts testing and assists in the hiring of lifeguards and instructors.
- Enforces rules and regulations pertaining to the pool.
- Assigns staff, supervises and evaluates their performance.
- Reviews, maintains and orders equipment.
- Conducts in-service training.
- Applies CPR and First Aid as needed.
- Maintains safety of beaches and all waterfront areas.

Supervisory Responsibilities

Manages two subordinate supervisors who supervise employees in the Recreation Department. Is responsible for the overall direction, coordination, and evaluation of this unit. Also directly supervises eight non-supervisory employees. Carries out supervisory responsibilities in accordance with the organization's policies and applicable laws. Responsibilities include interviewing, hiring, and training employees; planning, assigning, and directing work; appraising performance; rewarding and disciplining employees; addressing complaints and resolving problems.

Education and/or Experience

Bachelor's degree from four-year college or university; or one to two years' related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Lifeguard training and 2-3 years waterfront position, WSI with two years experience, First Aid, BLS, CPR, and current valid Driver's License
