Who: Persons 6 months of age and older

Did you know?

- According to CT law, all children under age 5 who are enrolled in a day care or pre-school must show proof of vaccination against the seasonal flu by January 1, 2013 in order to attend.

All daycare & preschool children aged 6 months to 59 months can receive the flu vaccine for FREE.

Adults and siblings who accompany the preschool children can also receive the flu shot for an additional fee. Children who are over the age of 5 may qualify for Vaccine Free for Children and receive the shot for free. Insurances accepted are Connecticare, Anthem BC/BS and Medicare. All others will be charged a \$25 fee if not eligible for vaccine free for children or no insurance. The types of vaccine available are injection and intranasal. No appointments necessary.
