

Rebuilding Our Community

Assistance for those facing energy-related reconstruction costs from the October 29, 2012 storm

IN THE AFTERMATH OF STORM SANDY, as our communities pull together to assess the damage and plan the rebuilding process, the state of Connecticut would like to offer its assistance.

We would like to offer rebate options for replacing heating and cooling systems, water heating systems and certain appliances.

Governor Dannel P. Malloy has announced that \$3 million is now available to provide residents relief from Storm Sandy with increased rebates to cover much of the cost difference between standard and high efficiency gas and electric equipment and new rebates for higher efficiency oil/propane furnace and boiler replacements.

These enhanced rebates will be available for replacement purchases of qualifying high-efficiency equipment between October 29 and December 31, 2012. Customers who require major renovations of their residence as a result of Storm Sandy may qualify for low-cost financing through participation in the Home Energy Solutions–Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® program. Proof of damage from Storm Sandy will be required for rebate submission.
