AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$10,890,000 FOR VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009

WHEREAS, an ordinance entitled “An Ordinance Appropriating \$10,890,000 For Various Public Improvements In The Capital Improvement Program For Fiscal Year 2008-2009” was enacted by the Town Council at its meeting on August 5, 2008 (the “Original Appropriation Ordinance”);

WHEREAS, the Original Appropriation Ordinance was amended by an ordinance entitled “An Ordinance Amending An Ordinance Appropriating \$10,890,000 For Various Public Improvements In The Capital Improvement Program For Fiscal Year 2008-2009” which was enacted by the Town Council at its meeting on June 14, 2010 (the “Amending Appropriation Ordinance”, and together with the Original Appropriation Ordinance, the “Appropriation Ordinance”);

WHEREAS, the Appropriation Ordinance authorizes the appropriation of \$200,000 for the costs associated with the line item “Town Facilities – Standby Generators: Emergency Management for Municipal Facilities” set forth therein (the “Generator Project”);

WHEREAS, the Generator Project was to be used for a standby generator at Town Hall which is no longer logistically feasible for the Town;

WHEREAS, the Town desires to commence a fleet study with respect to all Town vehicles which is estimated to cost approximately \$76,000 (the “Fleet Study Project”);

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the Town to amend the Appropriation Ordinance so as to properly finance the Fleet Study Project and to decrease the budget for the Generator Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STRATFORD:

Section 1. Section 1 of the Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended to reduce the amount of the appropriation for the line item "Town Facilities – Standby Generators: Emergency Management for Municipal Facilities" by \$76,000 from \$200,000 to \$124,000.

Section 2. Section 1 of the Appropriation Ordinance is hereby amended to add to the Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2008-2009 under "Capital Equipment" the line item "Capital Equipment - Fleet Study" with an appropriation amount of \$76,000.

Section 3. Except as specifically modified or amended herein, all other provisions of the Appropriation Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its passage pursuant to Section 2.2.9 of the Town Charter.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$10,890,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN TO MEET THE APPROPRIATION FOR VARIOUS PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 AND PENDING ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE

WHEREAS, an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Authorizing The Issuance Of \$10,890,000 Bonds of the Town To Meet The Appropriation For Various Public Improvements In The Capital Improvement Program For Fiscal Year 2008-2009 And Pending Issuance Thereof The Making of Temporary Borrowings For Such Purpose" was enacted by the Town Council at its meeting on August 5, 2008 (the "Bonding Ordinance");

WHEREAS, the Bonding Ordinance authorized bonding authorization up to \$200,000 for certain costs associated with the line item "Town Facilities – Standby Generators: Emergency Management for Municipal Facilities" (the "Generator Project");

WHEREAS, on December 18, 2008, the Town issued its \$8,730,000 General Obligation Bonds, Issue of 2008 that included \$200,000 of proceeds for the Generator Project;

WHEREAS, the Generator Project was to be used for a standby generator at Town Hall which is no longer logistically feasible for the Town;

WHEREAS, the Town desires to commence a fleet study with respect to all Town vehicles which is estimated to cost approximately \$76,000 (the "Fleet Study Project");

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the Town to amend the Bonding Ordinance to properly finance the Fleet Study Project and to decrease the budget for the Generator Project;

WHEREAS, the Town has together herewith enacted an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Amending An Ordinance Appropriating \$10,890,000 For Various Public Improvements in the Capital Improvement Program For Fiscal Year 2008-2009" by which the Town reduced the amount of the appropriation for the line item "Town Facilities – Standby Generators: Emergency Management for Municipal Facilities" by \$76,000 from \$200,000 to \$124,000 and added to the Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2008-2009 under

“Capital Equipment” the line item “Capital Equipment - Fleet Study” with an appropriation amount of \$76,000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STRATFORD:

Section 1. Section 1 of the Bonding Ordinance is hereby amended to (i) reduce the amount of bonding authorization set forth therein for the Generator Project by \$76,000 from \$200,000 to \$124,00 and (ii) increase the amount of bonding authorization set forth therein in order to bond for the \$76,000 of costs related to the Fleet Study Project.

Section 2. Except as specifically modified or amended herein, all other provisions of the Bonding Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective thirty days after its passage pursuant to Section 2.2.9 of the Town Charter.
