Stratford— The Town of Stratford Department of Community/Economic Development announces that due to the extraordinary demand for applications that will likely exceed the current amount of funds available for the program, they are no longer distributing new applications for the Residential Rehabilitation Program. In addition, they are not accepting completed applications from homeowners until additional funding become available. The Residential Rehabilitation Program offers no-interest, forgivable loans of up to \$25,000 for a five-year term to make repairs. Applications are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. The hold on the distribution of new applications and the receipt of completed applications is effective immediately. Interested homeowners are advised to continue to watch local weeklies and the Town's website for if, and when, the Department will begin to once again distribute new applications.
