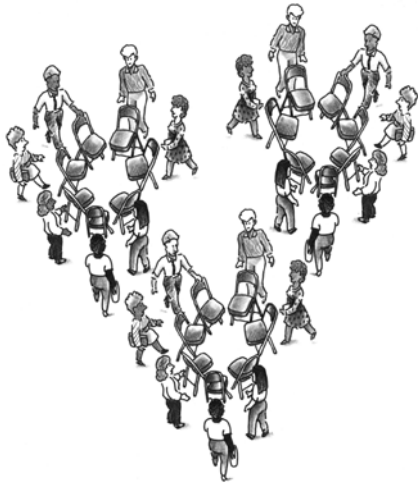


Conversation to Promote Racial Equity This Year Make a Difference – Do it in 2010!
