The Stratford EMS facility will be a like-new renovation of the existing Stratford Fire Headquarters.

The features of the new facility will provide:

- Completely renovated space that will house all of Stratford EMS operation and personnel.
- An apparatus bay which can hold up to six ambulance vehicles.
- Lower level floor plan which will include a Duty Room, Administrative Offices and Training Room.
- Upper level floor plan shall include a bunk sleeping area, kitchen, pantry as well as a day room.
- All new state-of-the-art electrical, mechanical and HVAC systems will be installed.
- New roof and new thermally efficient windows and doors will be installed.
