

Sikorsky Bridge Bikeway/Walkway



Highlights:

The Sikorsky Bridge Bikeway/Walkway was opened to the public in early 2007. The separated bike/pedestrian path is approximately 1 mile long. The walkway is paved, end-to-end, and provides spectacularly scenic views of the Housatonic River, Milford, Shelton, Stratford, and the islands in the Housatonic River. There is no admission fee for using the walkway. The walkway is accessible from either Ryder's Landing in Stratford or Wheeler's Farm Road in Milford.

Parking:

Parking is available at Ryder's Landing Shopping Center and at the State commuter lot located at Exit 53 of the Merritt Parkway in Stratford. On the Milford side, parking is available at the Boy Scout Headquarters on Wellington Road at Ext 55A traveling North and Exit 55 South on the Merritt Parkway.

Directions From Stratford Town Hall:

Head North on Main Street/CT-113
Follow Main Street for 2.3 miles
Continue on River Road/CT-110 for 1.4 miles
Take a slight right at Ryder's Lane
