The Town of Stratford CT and the Office of the Purchasing Agent, will receive SEALED BIDS for:

BID #2009-073 Sidewalk Improvements Project Due: 3:00 PM September 21, 2009

The scope of work involves the installation of new sidewalks, the replacement of deteriorated sidewalks, and allied construction on selected streets within the Town of Stratford. The intent of the project is to eliminate gaps in the sidewalk network on these streets.

The Instructions to Bidders, Bid Form, Contract Documents, Plans and Specifications, and Forms of Bid Bonds and Performance Bonds may be examined at the Office of the Purchasing Agent, Room 202, Town Hall, Stratford, Connecticut, upon payment of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each set made payable to the Town of Stratford. Any unsuccessful bidder, upon returning such set in good condition within fifteen (15) days of actual Bid Opening will be refunded their payment in full. Copies of the plans and specifications will be available for pick-up and review beginning **Friday, September 4, 2009**.

A pre-bid meeting for General Contractors and Sub-contractors will be held at Stratford Town Hall, Room 213, 2725 Main Street, Stratford, Connecticut, on September 10th at 10:00 AM.

Attention is called to the fact that this project is being funded through the Federal Community Development Block Grant Program and, as such, not less than the minimum salaries and wages, as set forth in the Bid Documents must be paid on this project. All bidders must certify that they are eligible to bid on the project and will comply with any and all applicable requirements of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. Bidders must also certify that they are not excluded from Federal Procurement or Non-Procurement Programs.

The Town of Stratford is an equal opportunity employer, and requires an Affirmative Action Policy for all its Contractors and Vendors, as a condition of doing business with the Town as per Federal Order 11246.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount of five (5%) of the total bid and subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders and Bid Proposal.
